BP & RBD LEACH'S DANYAS PRINCE OF DARKNESS Young B&T full of cute and very nicely made with bags of confidence. Very pretty head with excellent dome, broad nostrils, nice tight lips and the essential large well spaced eyes. Only a youngster but very tidy on the move and shows great promise for the future.

BB GOODWIN'S LANOLA MADEMOISELLE JW A lovely typy Tricolour with a pretty feminine head, showing good Charlie features. Excellent dome and ear placement, Nicely made and the right size for a girl. Moved with confidence and glamour but slightly lacking in enthusiasm.

RBB DIX'S BEEWYE PENELOPE PITSTOP Young tricolour who looked like a handful to show. Well made which showed in her movement, keeping a level topline and covering the ground well. Another pretty feminine

head, good width of skull and dome, with well spaced eyes and tidy lips.
