Not a huge entry but I was very happy with the quality of all the dogs and delighted to see the BOB shortlisted in a quality toy group.

Post Grad Dog (3,1)

1. Smith's Headra's Truly Magic Is Justacharma. Quality 20 month well marked Tri boy with a super temperament and ever wagging tail! Large masculine head with dark expressive eyes, well cushioned square muzzle, plenty of fill under eyes, good turn up and neatly finished lips. Wonderful body, short and compact, very cobby and with lovely front and rear angulation. Loved his size and neat shape with good bone, well cushioned feet and silky perfectly groomed coat to finish the picture. Moved around the ring with a free and easy action covering the ground effortlessly and maintaining a perfect topline. Thought he was a delightful little man and was in no doubt he should take BD but just couldn't match the head qualities of the bitch and so had to settle for BOS.

2. Maddison's Celxo Charles Dickens. Small, richly coloured ruby of a similar age to 1 but no where near as mature yet. Sweet head with defined stop, dark eyes and pigment, low set ears, well cushioned muzzle and good turn up. Good length to neck, level topline, correctly set tail and well angulated rear. Moved Ok just needs time to mature and gain a bit more confidence.

Open Dog (2)

1. Smith's Justacharma Oh So Magic JW. 4 year old lightly marked tri who is a real toy spaniel. Lovely head properties with good dome, low set, well feathered ears, square muzzle with good turn up and plenty of cushioning. Nicely constructed with good depth to chest, well sprung ribs, well angulated rear, well off for bone and neat, well cushioned feet. Moved well although he is not the most enthusiastic of showdogs so doesn't make the most of his qualities. RBD.

2. Maddison's Alambra Rich Ruby. 6  year old aptly named 'rich ruby' in good coat and great condition. Masculine head with dark eyes and well cushioned muzzle. Good neck and shoulders, well

turned stifles, good depth to chest and correctly carried tail, just a little long in back. Moved OK.

Puppy Bitch (2)

1. East's Nastane Alice. Sweet 6 month old baby Blen in a lovely quality coat already and groomed to perfection. Lovely head with super dome, correctly set ears, beautiful dark eyes, good turn up and lovely expression. Very neat little shape, square in outline with ample neck, good shoulders, perfect topline, good rear assembly and chest well developed for age. Was beautifully attentive to her handler and when she did get into her stride she demonstrated sound movement. Was delighted to award her BPIB.

2. Dix's Beewye Precious Perdita. An extremely happy 11 month tri baby who has a lovely expression, beautiful dark eyes, good head shape and turn up. Not quite as compact as 1 and not carrying much coat but overall a very nice puppy who just needs to settle in order to show off her qualities.

Junior Bitch (2)

1. Robinson's Baldragon Tantrum and Tiaras. Heavier marked small tri, another with an attractive head, good dome, large dark eyes and long, low set ears. Compact frame with moderate neck, level topline, deep chest and good sweep of stifle. Moved very smartly round the ring maintaining a level topline and good tail carriage.

2. Dix's Beewye Penelope Pitstop. Litter sister to 2nd in puppy and very similar in type to Perdita. Again, has a super happy temperament with her whole back end in constant motion wagging her tail! Love her pretty head and mischievous expression, good dome and turn up, neatly finished lips and plenty of cushioning to her muzzle and fill under eyes. She is soundly constructed all through and at times concentrated enough to allow this to be reflected in her movement! Quality baby who just needs to concentrate a tiny bit more on the job in hand!

Post Grad Bitch (1)

1. Smith's Rexlands Camomile Is Justacharma. 20 month attractively marked blen in good coat and condition. Nice compact shape with well developed chest, straight front, short

level back and parallel rear. Nice, well cushioned head with dark eyes and dense pigment, good width to jaw, nice dome and low set ears. Moved well with a relaxed, effortless gait, just a little close going away.

Open Bitch (3) Three super girls.

1. Robinson's Baldragon She Demands JW. Eyecatching, strikingly marked tri nearing 2 years old. Super feminine head with great dome, gorgeous expressive eyes with plenty of fill underneath, good width to muzzle with super cushioning and turn up. Lovely arched neck, well laid shoulders, perfect topline, deep chest, straight front, well angulated rear and good tail set. Moved with purpose around the ring showing lovely reach and drive with head held high and tail carried perfectly. Handled to an advantage to really show off her many qualities. She had the best head of the day and coupled with her sound construction she was an easy choice for BB and just pipped the dog to BOB. I was delighted to later see her shortlisted in the Toy Group and heard less than a week later she gained her crown. Well done! BB, BOB.

2. Willey & Siddle's Penemma Sweet Dream. Ultra sweet, very pretty, lightly marked blen who is a fraction larger than 1 with a lovely cobby body, super neck and shoulders, deep chest and well angulated rear end all giving a very attractive typical outline. Pretty, very well cushioned head with nicely domed skull, dark expressive eyes, defined stop and correctly set ears framing her sweet face. She came to life on the move with a lovely effortless motion looking especially good in profile maintaining a wonderful, elegant outline. RBB.

3. Cox's Headra's Chocolate Brownie at Churchchis. Loved this girls size and type but she just wouldn't concentrate on the move which was a shame.
