Vet D or B (5:2) 1. Smith's Justacharma She's Magic. Tri bitch, almost 10 yrs old. Well balanced cobby body, sweet head and expression. Enjoying her outing. 2. Stone's Maynorth Simply Heaven. Smart b/t, nice dark eyes, moved out gaily. 3. Chandler's Bonniroy Butterfly Barleybright

MPD (1:1)

PD (5:0) 1. Mochrie's Downsbank Guthrie. Tri dog who oozes quality and excels in head, lovely domed skull, dark round eyes with nose well placed and well cushioned muzzle. Lovely balance and sound mover. 2. Baker's Cofton A Team Day Dream. Another really promising tri puppy, attractive head and well balanced outline, well placed ears, good front and compact round feet. I'm sure we will be hearing more of these two in the coming year. 3. Mochries Downsbank Montgomery

JD (8:1) 1. Pennington's Tudorhurst Corsair. Attractive young b/t boy who moved with style. Well domed head with dark round eyes, well placed nose, good reach of neck, deep ribcage, straight front and good turn of stifle, finished with sufficient silky coat enhanced by rich red tan markings. BIS. 2. Smith's Hedra's Truly Magic is Justacharma. Nicely marked and well constructed Tri dog, who has a cobby outline, straight front and moved out well. 3. Mochries Bonitos Companeros Deluxe High Society

GD ((5:1) 1. Mochrie's Bonitos Companeros Deluxe High Society. Well balanced and nicely made tri dog. Well shaped head, dark eyes, good cushioning. Moved well. 2. Schemel's Elliot Van Der Gebhardshoh. Larger tri, well broken markings, sturdy body, expressive round dark eyes. 3. Salguero's Downsbank Fletcher

PGD (2:1). Austin's Oh Dandy Boy Hero. Blen boy, liked his overall shape, deep ribcage, broad skull, well placed nose. Moved soundly holding his topline on the move and showed beautifully.

LD (5:1) 1. Salguero's Downsbank Bilbo Baggins. Most appealing head and expression, lovely dome, well placed ears and nose with well opened nostrils. In super coat and on his best behaviour today,

moved and showed steadily. RBD. 2. Portingdale and Pennington's Tudorhurst Pirate King. Smart b/t, very masculine type, good front, level topline, nice dark eye. 3. Smith's Justacharma Oh So Magic

OD (4:0) 1. Pennington's Endless Love De La Montagne Ensoleillee. Very compact, lightly marked Blenheim, lovely type, deep chest, good topline, nice turn of stifle. 2. Austin's Baldragon Big It Up. Happy tri boy, nicely shaped head with lovely dark eyes, a little longer in back than winner, he moved and showed well. 3. Goodwin's Tucherish Stanley Diggle

MPB (2:0) 1. Mochrie's Lorphil Glimpse of Ebony on Downsbank. Lightly marked tri with the sweetest most feminine head and expression. Good overall balance, when she bodies up and matures I'm sure she will trouble the best. 2. Hunter's Kingsleigh Zophie at Hooebarton. Just 6 mths and very immature but a very promising little b/t. Another pretty head with domed skull and good cushioning, nice reach of neck and level topline. Giving a lot away in age today.

PB (2:0) Two really lovely young bitches with not a whisker between them who I am sure will change places on a regular basis 1. Smith's Rexlands Camomile is Justacharma. Beautiful young Blen, well shaped head with all the essentials in place, giving a soft feminine expression. Good turn of stifle, moved soundly, holding her shape on the move.

2. Baker's Cofton Walking on Sunshine. Tri girl, I have simply written all of the above apply to her too. On the day just felt winner had a slight edge on front movement on the floor surface.

JB. (7:1) Robinsons Baldragon She Demands. Twelve months on the day. Most beautifully headed tri girl, well placed nose, darkest of eyes and long silky ears. Very well put together, deep chest, cobby body, good bone and feet. Moved soundly and beautifully presented. RBB and BPIS. 2. Portingdale & Pennington's Tudorhurst Black Swan. B/t who excels in outline. Short and cobby with good spring of rib, Attractive feminine head, appealing expression with darkest round eyes. 3. Goodwin's Phydeaux Royal Rose for Diggle

GB (4:2) 1. Mochrie's Downsbank Evensong. Really lovely little tri, very cobby, deep ribcage, plenty of bone, compact well feathered feet, lovely well shaped head with sweetest of expressions. Just needs more confidence to complete the picture. 2. Lewis's Carletto Sweet Melody. Tri, pretty head, good topline, longer on the leg and not as mature in body as winner.

PGB (3:0) 1. Austin's Baldragon May Bea Baby. Small compact Tri who moved really well. Nice overall balance, happy showgirl. 2. Stone's Maynorth Lovesong. Slightly larger tri, well made, well sprung ribs, level topline, nicely domed head, well feathered long ears. 3. Jones' Vashdown Contralto

LB (2:1) 1. V Contralto. Cobby little tri, nice deep ribcage, well cushioned muzzle. Not too happy in the hall.

OB 1.(6:1) Goodwin's Ch Maibee Clementine for Lanola. BB & RBIS. Very worthy Ch, sturdy body, lovely outline, deep well sprung ribcage, plenty of bone. Beautiful feminine head, melting expression, dark eyes. In the challenge I just felt she just lacked her usual sparkle
2. Harvey's Rocquencourt Rosetta Royal at Rivermoor. Very nice b/t girl, in lovely coat, well domed skull, slightly longer cast than winner. 3. Robinson's Baldragon All About Me.

SPO B/T or Ruby (4:1)1. Mochrie's Cavella Cupar. Pretty b/t, well shaped skull and nicely cushioned muzzle. Cobby body, well balanced outline and sound mover. 2. Stone's Maynorth Fallen From Heaven. Ruby, Nicely domed skull, well set nose with large open nostrils and dark eyes. Not quite as compact as winner. 3. Salguero's Chacombe Lorcan

SPO Blen or Tri 1.(4:0) 1. Robinson's Baldragon Heaven Scent. Happy tri showgirl, deep well sprung ribcage, plenty of bone, nice reach of neck flowing into level topline, pretty feminine head with lovely long well placed ears. 2. B May Bea Baby. 3. C Sweet Melody

SP Beg (4:0) 1. Austin's Baldragon Grace and Favour. Pettty young blen bitch. Still very immature but good overall shape, well domed skull, nice reach of neck, well set ears with good feathering. 2. Oh Dandy Boy Hero. 3. Arundel & Brown's Carleeto Truly Scrumptious.
