MPD 2) I Mochrie's Downsbank Nocturne. Carrying a good body and coat for one so young, nice head, good outline, moved well. 2 Williams' Kasamanda Chasing A Dream. Not quite as balanced in outline, nice head, good neck and shoulders, level topline.

PD (3, 1) I Champion's Headras Moorcroft At Lankcombe. Both of these puppies were out to make their handlers workhard ! Good head and eyes, well laid shoulders, longer in body, eventually settled to move. 2 Baker's Cofton Crazy ForYou. Nice head and expression, dark large eyes, shorter coupled but not as positive in hind movement today.

JD (4, 1) I Bailey's Aldoricka The Maverick. Very nice overall shape, good head and dark eyes which gave a good expression, level topline. 2 Byers' Paulian Ernest Another nice dog who really new how to move, well shaped head. 3 Maddison's Mitapip Midnight Marauder.

PGD (10, 2) I Dawson & Jones' Pomelo Triple Chance. Settled to move well, nice head, dark eyes, good topline, moved with drive. 2 Smith's Justacharma Oh So Magic JW Loveiy type with a good outline but just not happy on the slippery floor today, good head, level topline. 3 Hopkins' Rexlands Brimstone.

LD {10, 3) I Pascoe's Cwmtirion Little Boy Peep. Lovely type with a great outline, level topline and good ribcage, good neck and well laid shoulders, lovely well shaped head and good expression. 2 Mochrie's Downsbank Spruce. Large head, plenty of cushioning to face, dark eye, good ribs, short loin, good overall shape and carrying plenty of body. 3 Mallows & Gillhespy's Binglui Berlington Bertie.

OD (8, 1) I Moffat's CH Maibee Theo. CC and BOB. Really fell for the charms of this young man, he has the most lovely outline and free flowing movement A joy to watch going round the ring, good ribcage, body, well muscled hindquarters, super head with well domed skull, square muzzle, large dark eyes and carrying a lovely silky coat 2 Fry & Jackson's Ch Amantra Cheers. Res CC. Lovely type and quality, tricolour male, good wide and deep chest excellent body and level topline, super head and expression, moved with ease. 3 Gillhespy's Tucherish Sundance JW.

MPB(10, 1) | Gillhespy's Downsbank Designed For Lorphil. BP, really loved this baby, very confident nice outline and good movement, loved her head and expression, good topline, topped off with plenty of sparkle. 2 Fry & Jackson's Amantra Cherish. Very close up to my winner, in fact two lovely puppies headed this strong class, good outline and movement lovely head and expression. 3 Lewis' Carleeto Sweet Melody. PB (6, 1) | Rushton's Amantra Summer Cherub. Nice size young lady who was full of herself, lovely head and expression, good level topline, well angulated hindquarters, moved with ease. 2 Giddings' Amantra Summer Cheer. Blen, well constructed youngster, good head and expression, dark expressive eyes, well laid shoulders, just needs to body up. 3 Mochrie's Downsbank Liberty Belle. JB (4) | Sidgwick's Paulian Amazing Grace. My BCC. Loved her type and quality, super outline both standing and on the move, easy flowing movement large well domed skull, square muzzle, large dark eyes, good ribcage and body, good silky texture of coat. A delight 2 Goodwin's Amantra Queen Of Clubs At Diggle. Not as free flowing in movement good head, good ribcage and body, level topline, nice outline, good silky coat. 3 Johnson's Hedra's Delphine At Alambra, PGB (2) | Mochrie's Downsbank Valentina. Nice type of bitch who settled to move well, well domed skull, dark expressive eyes, good neck and shoulders. 2 Mallows' Binglui Ruby Junella. Ruby bitch who was just very unsure of the slippery floor, so did not make the most of herself, lovely type, good head and expression. LB (2, 1) | Smith's Justacharma Something Magic JW Would prefer a little less body as it made her look loaded over the shoulders, moved confidently. OB (6) | Goodwin's Maibee Clementine Of Lanola. Feminine, good head, well cushioned, long ears, deep well developed chest level back, beautifully presented and moving well, just wish she had a bit more animation which would enhance her many charms.
