1. SALGUERO'S TEWHIT THESPIAN. Blen with correct head shape, round dark eyes, good nose placement, well marked coat, good front, good rear angulation giving sound movement. BV.

MPD (7, 1abs).

1. WATERS & ROBINS' MAIBEE MR KIPLING. Tri, real baby with lovely head shape, short back, good body for age, lightly marked, moved well fore and aft. Shows promise.

2. JACKSON'S AMANTRA SUMMER POET. Blen, a little longer cast than 1, very good headshape, well coated, nicely marked, moved well.

3. SCHILIZZI & HEALEY'S BALDRAGON ROYAL WARWICK OF CHACOMBE.

PD (6,4).

1.SHEPHERD'S WESTONBIRT GOLDEN CHARMER. Ruby with well shaped head, round eyes, good front, well bodied, nice coat of rich colour, moving soundly.

2. JUNIPER'S LEWISCAROL LORD OF THE DANCE. Tri, rather nose, eyes could be darker, nice ears, moved steadier in this class.

1. SMITH'S JUSTACHARMA OH SO MAGIC. Tri with good dome, good profile, nice earset and length, good body shape, level topline, good coat, moves and shows well.

2. SIDGWICK'S PAULIAN PATENTED. Tri with nice head but preferred profile of 1, nice dark eyes, short level back, moves soundly, nicely marked coat.

3. AUSTIN'S OH DANDY BOY HERO.

ND (5,3).

1.LUNT'S BEECHGLEN GABRIEL. Tri with lovely tan markings, well shaped masculine head, good dome, lovely long ear fringes, good body, straight front, well marked coat, moves a little close behind.

2.AUSTIN'S OH DANDY BOY HERO Blen, head in profile slopes, muzzle needs to fill out, rich red markings on nice coat, moves steadily.

LUNT'S BEECHGLEN SUMMERTIME JW Blen with correct dome, good width to muzzle, well marked coat with rich tan, very good body shape, good front.

2. MALLOWS' BINGLUI BERLINGTON BERTIE. Ruby with very good head, dark eyes, well cushioned muzzle, good front, nice body shape, right out of coat.

3. SIDGWICK'S PAULIAN PATENTED.

1. MOCHRIE'S DOWNSBANK SPRUCE. Tri with good dome, good width of muzzle well cushioned, good front, nice body shape, covers the ground well when moving, nicely marked coat, good tan.

2. MADDISON'S ALAMBRA RICH RUBY. Well named ruby, lovely head and expression, round dark eyes, good front, in good coat but could be straighter, moves soundly.

3.AUSTIN'S BALDRAGON BIG IT UP.

1.KENDALL & ASKINS' HEADRA'S CHOCOLATE D'LITE
Tri with lovely masculine head, good dome, broad muzzle, round dark eyes, low set ears, long fringes, short level back, moved really well, well marked coat.

2. MOSS'S OTHMESE COLE FOR SOMBUR. B/T, lovely head shape, good profile, dark eyes, good tan markings, cobby shape, good front, nice coat, moved well.

3. MALLOWS & GILLHESPY'S TUCHERISH JOLYON.

OD (5,0).

1. WATERS & ROBINS' CH MAIBEE THEO. Lightly marked tri with correct head shape, good profile, long well set ears, straight front, short back, good topline, moving soundly. RDCC.

2. FRY'S AMANTRA REGALIST. Tri with lovely head shape, good dome, good nose placement, nice broad muzzle, dark eyes, good coat, movement was sound but seemed a little tense.

3. SIDGWICK'S FIN, EST, SW, CH PAULIAN PADDINGTON JW.

SpO B/T D (3,0).

1. GILLHESPY'S TUCHERISH SUNDANCE. Lovely head and eye, rich tan markings, good profile, short back, good coat, moves well, a little proud of his tail.

2. OTHMESE COLE FOR SOMBUR.

3. TUDORHURST BRIGADIER.

SpO RubyD (3,0).

1. STEWART'S CH MARCHOG MACFLANNEL. Lovely head with dark eyes, good nose placement, firm body with good front, moves soundly, not in his best coat today.

2. GILLHESPY'S LORPHIL COPPER SUNRISE JW. Very close to winner, lovely head and expression, dark eyes, good rear action, good coat of rich colour.

3. SALGUERO'S CHACOMBE LORCAN.

SpO TriD (8,3).

1. FRY & JACKSON'S CH AMANTRA CHEERS. A beautiful example of a King Charles, excellent masculine head with correct dome, wide muzzle, good finish to mouth, dark eyes, good nose placement, low set ears with good

fringing, very good body shape, strides out covering the ground with ease. **DCC & BIS.**

2. SMITH'S AGEANCOURT MAGIC ONCE MORE IS JUSTACHARMA. Lightly marked with good headshape but unlucky to meet the winner, good front, sound hindquarters giving good movement.

3. LUNT'S BEECHGLEN GABRIEL.

SpO Blend (4,0).

1. PORTINGALE'S TUDORHURST MATADOR. Very good headshape with good pigment, broad muzzle, cobby body, rich tan markings, moves well when settled.

2. TARABAD'S LILLIJAY PERCY CUTE KHATIBI. Very similar to winner with nice dome but slopes in profile, front not his fortune.

3. LUNT'S BEECHGLEN SUMMERTIME JW.

VB (2,0).

1. COUPLAND'S CH TUCHERISH VIOLETTA.. Tri with typy head, good dome, dark eyes, short level back, nice silky coat, well marked, moves steadily.

2. WILLIAMS' KASAMANDA MY LITTLE MADAM. Larger tri, good head and eye, long ears, good coat, moving well for age.

MPB (11,2).

1. ROBINSON'S BALDRAGON ALL ABOUT ME Very promising tri, nice head with good dome, cobby shape with good topline, good front, firm hindquarters, moves out well, good temperment.

2. HARVEY'S NASTANE DOROTHY, Promising blen baby with good dome, at present a little strong in underjaw, well bodied, good bone, firm topline, good rear angulation giving positive movement.

3. KENDALL & ASKINS' REXLAND BEGUILE.

PB (12,6).

1. KENDALL & ASKINS' HEADRA'S MISS CADBURY. Was very taken with this B/T girl, lovely head shape, nice eyes,

good neck, very good body with straight front, rich tan markings, moves very soundly but full of herself. BP.

1. PENNINGTON'S FOLIE D'AMOUR POURTOI DE LA MONTAGNE ENSOLEILLEE B/T, lovely head shape, good dome, wide well filled muzzle, lovely round eyes, good nose placement, very good body shape, rich tan markings, nice coat, moves and shows very well.

2. DIX'S PAULIAN PRUDENCE FOR BEEWYE. Very pretty tri, good dome, muzzle needs to fill out, short and cobby, good topline, lightly marked with good tan, moves and shows well.

3. WILLEY & SIDDLE'S PENEMMA SWEET DREAM.

NB (8,3).

1. FRY & JACKSON'S AMANTRA TOPAZ. attractive tri girl with very good head shape, nice wide muzzle, well cushioned, good front, well angulated hind legs giving good movement.

2. MEEK'S SLEEPYHOLLOW INKY PINKY. Tri, very pretty with correct dome, good width to muzzle, level topline, good body shape, needs to settle on the move.

3. WILLEY & SIDDLE'S PENEMMA SWEET DREAM

GB (3,0).

1. SEARLE'S STONEPIT DOLLY DAYDREAM. Blen, lovely head shape with good dome, nice eyes, good nose placement, good width of muzzle, straight front, good bodyshape, moved very well covering the ground easily, nicely marked coat.

2. FRY & JACKSON'S AMANTRA SUMMER CHINTZ. Blen of very good type, good head and eye, nice reach of neck, good topline, pity she was out of coat.

3. BYERS' MAIBEE ANYA AT SIMANNIE.

B/T, very good quality type, mother of JB winner, good head shape with correct dome, good wide muzzle, good nose placement, round eyes, mature body, shiny black coat with rich tan markings, moves soundly.

2. ROBINSON'S BALDRAGON HEAVEN SCENT. Tri with very pretty head with good dome but needs more width to muzzle, good body with firm topline, good action.

3. COUPLAND'S TUCHERISH SEBASTIENNE

LB (13,3)

1 COUPLAND'S.TUCHERISH CLEMENCY. Tri with well domed head, good profile, nice cushioning to muzzle, good front, nicely crested neck, good topline, well coated, lovely outline when moving.

2. HARVEY'S ROCQUENCOURT ROSETTA ROYAL AT RIVERMOOR. B/T with good type head, correct dome, good profile, well filled muzzle, dark eyes, very good body shape, straight front, good rear angulation, moving very soundly.

3. LUNT'S BEECHGLEN DAISY.

OB (7,1)

1. FRY & JACKSON'S CH AMANTRA WINTERBERRY.

Heavily marked tri with rich tan markings, well shaped head with good width to muzzle, good front, well ribbed body, good hind angulation giving driving movement, very good coat.

2.KENDALL & ASKINS' AMANTRA CHARMFUL AT HEADRA. Very close to winner, lovely head, just preferred the width of 1, good length of neck, firm topline, good coat, moves very well.

3. STONE'S MAYNORTH IRRESISTIBLE JW.

SpO B/TB (6,3).

1. GILLHESPY'S CH TUCHERISH LUCRETIA BORGIA.

Lovely head and eye, correct width of muzzle, low set ears

well fringed, well built with good front, firm top line, nice silky coat, good tan, very full of herself, moving very well. RBCC.

2. SMITH'S MAPLEHURST BLUE MAGIC IS JUSTACHARMA.

Pleasing head, good body shape with good topline, straight front, good tan markings, moves well in profile, a little close behind going away.

3. GRAVES' PAMEDNA PEGGY SUE.

SpO RubyB (2,1).

1. JUNIPER'S LEWISCAROL AMERETTO. Could do with a better dome, good eye shape, good body, very out of coat but the bit she had was a good colour, moves close behind.

SpO TriB (5,2).

1. ROBINSON'S CH NASTANE MISS DIOR AVEC

BALDRAGON. Lovely girl, excellent head with good dome, well cushioned muzzle, low set ears with long fringes, nicely marked coat, straight front, good topline, very energetic mover giving good drive behind.

2. AUSTIN'S COFTON BOP TO THE TOP. Pretty girl, nicely marked coat, head would look better with more width to muzzle, moves soundly.

3. ROBINSON & AUSTINS BALDRAGON MAY BEA BABY.

1. WATERS & ROBINS' MAIBEE OLIVIA. This lovely girl has everything you could wish for in a King Charles bitch, very good bone, very good body shape, lovely head with good dome, well cushioned muzzle, round dark eyes, low set long ears, lightly marked coat, shows and moves very well, one I would be proud to own.
