PD (4,1) 1 Gillhespy & Mallow's Tucherish Jolyon. 7 months b/w promising baby, good condition, very raw in all departments as you would expect with this breed but moved well enough and has pretty head and ears. 2 Matches' Tucherish The Black Knight. b/tan little longer in body and not so keen on the ring yet. 3 Mochrie's Downsbank Jefferson.

PGD (5,2) 1 Mesdames Waters & Robins' Maibee Bittersweet. White with orange markings, absolutely stunning domed head, eyes to melt your heart, well set ears, beautiful cheeks. Square muzzle, nice finish to jaw. Silky coat, good legs and feet. Enough neck to carry himself with importance around the ring. Very sound mover, just loved him. Dog CC his first. 2 Matches' Tucherish Florison Of Fochai. Tri colour, a good type of dog generally without the extravagant skull of winner but generally pleasing in all departments. 3 Maddison's Tucherish Angelo.

LD (2,0) 1 Rushton's Tiflin Tudor Royal JW. Tricolour, very free on the move. Level topline, liked his large eyes, long ears, not overdone anywhere just a nice dog. 2 Mochrie's Maramond Satchmo Downsbank (US Imp). b/tan slightly heavier in appearance, good type of dog but not so settled moving today as winner.

OD (3,0) 1 Mesdames Waters & Robins' Rytonion Out Of The Blue. b/tan coat not at its best but short cobby body and deep brisket. Long ears, cheeks well cushioned, lovely domed skull, strong mover. 2 Mochrie's Rosschild Oscar At Downsbank JW. Blenheim with a pleasing shaped dome head, little longer cast than winner, and not so steady moving. 3 Fry's Check Mate Amantra.

PB (4,1) 1 Mochrie's Downsbank Julietta. tri with a lovely head, pretty little girl but all over the place on the move. 2 Robinson's Tucherish Lulu Belle. tri with a sweet headpiece and good body.

Short coupled, has promise. 3 Coupland's Tucherish Sarsaparilla.

JB (5,0) 1 Loynd's Crimbledale Solitaire. A tri with the best head in the class and best mover. Good facial properties, sufficient angulation on the rear, nice legs and feet. 2 Maguire's Stonepit Daisy Chains For Sharran. Blenheim with a lovely face and good skull shape but again moving was the problem today. 3 Mallows' Lorphil Copper Delight Binglui. Res Johnson's Lorphil Black Sapphire At Alambra. VHC Sidgwick's Paulian Faith.

PGB (4,2) 1 Mesdames Waters & Robins' Maibee Rosetint. Another typical exhibit from this kennel, tri, super width of jaw, lovely eyes, ears well set and hanging right. Good ribs. 2 Mochrie's Downsbank Fenella. tri, lighter in body and not moving as well today.

LB (5,0) 1 Sidgwick's Paulian Patience JW. Extrovert little lady, tri, cobby body, nice skull shaped and large eyes. Has pleasing quarters back and front. Good tail set. Moved very well. Presented in beautiful condition. Res BCC. 2 Mesdames B J, Essex & Jackson's Amantra Little Dorrit. tri, not so enthusiastic in the cause today but her breed points fitted the bill. 3 Randle & Pritchards' Rosssonny My Girl Lillijay. Res Johnson's Jacrianna Holly Blue At Alambra. VHC Coupland's Tucherish Henrianna.

OB (3,0) 1 Mesdames Waters & Robins' Ch Maibee Emily. Blenheim who outmoved all the opposition here, has a beautiful domed head, a real dome, wide nostrils, good turn up of jaw, nice finish and lovely cheeks. Well shaped body, shoulders well laid back, neat in elbows. BCC. 2 Mallows' Lorphil Copper Cobana Binglui. Ruby, pretty little girl generally got the points. 3 Loy's Crimbledale Regal Rose.
