PD (1) 1 Baker's Cofton On My Own. What a very promising young Blenheim. Correct in height and short in body. Really fabulous head properties and the darkest of pigment. Marked perfectly in body and has the much desired lozenge on head. Moved with verve and attitude, just needs to tighten up a tad in the rear. Has all the attributes to make a very exciting adult.

JD (3) 1 Byers' Simannie Giovanni Bach. Tri of true breed type. Correct blocking to head leading into adequate neck. He is deep and short sporting correct coby body with excellent rear angulation which he used to advantage on the move. Coming towards me he was more difficult to assess due to the wonderful smells on the ground and the need to enjoy them! 2 Skelton's Pomelo Second Chance At Elfindor. Tri youngster with wonderful rich tan markings set in an attractive correct head. Outstanding front assembly with good depth in body and excellent rear angulation. Once settled he moved soundly both ways, however, he is somewhat proud of his tail. He is way too thin and needs more weight especially at this critical age if he is going to fulfil his true potential. 3 Kendall's Headra's Irresistible. Just had to include a few lines regarding this beautiful Blenheim, he has the most melting of expressions, ultra dark pigmentation this all leads into an elegant neck, well placed shoulders and short deep body. Just lost out on maturity but will watch him mature with interest.

YD (1) 1 Skelton's Pomelo Second Chance At Elfindor. 2nd in JD.

ND (2) 1 Baker's Cofton Daydream Believer. Tri, beautifully put together, short and deep with excellent angles. Bright tan markings enhanced his excellent head qualities. A typical full on male who was having far too much fun to concentrate on the matter of showing himself off! 2 Skelton's Pomelo Second Chance At Elfindor. 2nd in JD.

LD (4) 1 Arrowsmith Vorderstrasse & Hubbard's Arrowbien Eng Breakfast. My clear winner of the day, presented to perfection. He is deep and coby with an excellent spring of ribcage. Head sports correct eye, ear and nose placement, with the darkest of pigment. Exceptional in neck with a wonderful crest which he carried with such elegance on the move. So well off for bone without being course. His markings are textbook and just go to enhance this quality exhibit. Moved well and positively. Could not deny him his second CC and BOB. I am confident he will gain his crown. 2 Arundel & Southam's Chacombe Fin. Not yet as mature and finished as my winner, but still a top quality dog. I liked so much about this boy, he is not overdone in anyway. So well put together and very much my type. Still needs to mature and I am confident will then make up to a worthy Champion. RCC. 3 Harvey's Rivermoor Alberto. What a glorious head this boy has, so correct, so gentle, so melting. He carries many of the breed attributes that many exhibits lack. His front assembly is exceptionally good. Loved his size and markings. Shown in pristine condition. He moved so soundly coming towards me. Sadly his Achilles heel is lack of confidence which tends to be portrayed especially in his rear action on the move by dropping his croup and tucking his tail down meaning I found him impossible to assess.

OD (1) 1 Kendall & Wileman's Chocolate Moonlight At Headra. On entering the ring I thought this boy would push hard for the CC. His head is exceptional with wonderful rise and correct dome. Particularly well constructed front assembly which he used to advantage on the move however his rear action let him down and denied him top honours. Immaculately presented.

PB (3, 1) 1 Lovel's Cofton Dreamed A Dream At Lovetrac. And what a dream this little girl is, so balanced throughout, a top drawer youngster and not overdone in anyway. Presented immaculately. She sports the most feminine of heads with darkest of pigment, leading into well placed shoulders, deep and cobby body with great rear angulation which she used to advantage on the move. BPIB and worthy winner of Group 3 on the day. 2 Nemeth's Arrowbien The Sphinx. Another top draw baby, I so love the head of this girl. Great neck and shoulder placement, short body and good rear assembly. Somewhat exuberant on the move. Not as balanced as my winner today. Will enjoy watching both girls as they progress through the classes.

JB (1)1 Byers' Simannie Maid In Wales. When I looked at my notes the first thing I read was Shelagh, I really had little need to write more! This tri girl is my template for a classic bitch head, I found it difficult to fault. She did not disappoint in construction, lovely size, depth with desired cobiness. So excited to watch this girl mature. She moved steadily and soundly to take a well deserved RCC.

YB (1) 1 Baker's Cofton Blue Velvet. Wonderful head construction, short and deep in rib she made a wonderful shape on the stack. She has excellent shoulder placement and good stifle angulation. Very sound, positive and happy on the move.

PGB (2) 1 Baker's Cofton Fly Me To The Moon. She certainly went to the moon today. What an honest little girl, not overdone in anyway, very hard to fault. The sweetest of expressions, deep dark melting eyes. She totally ticked my boxes today and moved so soundly with such presence I could not deny her the CC. 2 Skelton's Tudorhurst Sorceress At Elfindor. The sweetest Blenheim with the prettiest of heads and the darkest of pigmentation. She is so well constructed, perfect for size and sound on the move. Just felt today she was not carrying enough show conditioning for top honours, however her quality cannot be denied.

LB (3) 1 Lewis & Lewis' Amantra Tarazed Carleeto. A girl who needs to be handled to be fully appreciated, her dark markings should not detract from her attractive and well constructed head in which she sports the most wonderful large dark eyes. She is beautifully made with elegant neck and well-set shoulders, deep and short. Once settled on the move she moved freely and soundly. I may have considered her further if she had been in her best dress. 2 Skelton's Tudorhurst Sorceress At Elfindor. 2nd PGB.

OB (2) 1 Southam's Cavella Camelia. What a dainty feminine girl with a most appealing expression and wonderful head properties. She is a quality girl and so correct to go over, she really appealed to me a lot. Moved so well coming but a tad close moving away. I considered her for higher honours but for my personal preference I would like her to carry a bit more weight and furnishings to complete the picture. 2 Skelton's Tudorhurst Sorceress At Elfindor. 2nd PG.
