Puppy Dog

1st: Mr & Mrs SMITH's JUSTACHARMA SO MAGIC. Most promising well proportioned tricolour puppy who presented a lovely outline. Typical head with good width of skull, dark eye and gentle expression, correct earset giving a nice dome. Good length of neck and well angulated front and rear. Ideal size with compact body and good rib and bone. Moved well keeping a level topline. **BEST PUPPY**

2nd: CONSTABLE's Mitapip Royal Command. Small b/t who lacked the confidence of winner. Nice shape, pretty head and good neck and shoulder.

3rd: TONNER's HEADRA'S LEO at HALBINSEL

Junior Dog 1st: Mr & Mrs RYAN's Cavallibrook Blimey O Riley. Smart, free moving tricolour who presented a good outline both standing and on the move keeping his level topline at all times. Correct head with good dome, large dark eye, good length of neck, compact body and good bone. Very confident.

2nd: Mr & Mrs SMITH's CAVELLA COMRADE is JUSTACHARMA. Well marked tri with a lovely head, broad skull, dark eye and kind expression. Well made all through. Short back, cobby body and good bone. Just not moving as well as one above. A very promising puppy who should have a good future.

Post Graduate Dog

1st: MADDISON's Justacharma Northern Magic. Stood alone but deserved his place. Nice type, happy tricolour very typical of his breeding. Correct head type with good dome and well set ears. Moved well..

Limit Dog

1st: Mr & Mrs STEWART's Monleon Made By Magic for Marchog. Well made Blenheim of lovely type and size. Beautifully made with nice arched neck and compact well ribbed body. Broad skull, good earset, large dark eyes, well cushioned foreface and nice turn up. Moved very well keeping a good outline. **Res.CC**

2nd: CLARKE's Poltomic Black Magic. Another very typical Charlie. B/t with a beautiful head, broad skull, long well fringed ears correctly placed to give a good dome. Well constructed with good spring of rib and compact body. Moved well keeping his good topline.

3rd: GILLHESPY & KIRSCHBAUM's Bonitos Companeros Deluxe Chardonnay

Open Dog

1st: BOWLES-ROBINSON's Baldragon Shoots He Scores. Well known tricolour dog who is impossible to overlook. Broad masculine head with large dark eye, well cushion foreface, good width of jaw, correctly placed ears and good dome. Well angulated front and rear with good length of neck, short cobby body and deep chest with ample rib. He excels on the move with good reach and drive holding a level and good tail carriage. **CC & BOB.**

2nd: Mr & Mrs SMITH's . Ch. Justacharma Magic Goes On. Nice headed tricolour with kind expression. I liked his size and shape. Good neck and shoulder, nice bend of stifle, level topline and good spring of rib. In full coat. Moved very well.

3rd: CLARKE's - Stonepit Wilfred for Poltomic.

Veteran Dog

1st: Mr & Mrs TONNER's - Headra's Inspiration at Halbinsel. Nice size 7 year old Tricolour in lovely condition for his age. Good skull, dark eyes, pleasing expression. Moved well.

Special Beginners Dog or Bitch

1st: ABBOTT's Helmajon Rhapsody in Blue. Well marked tricolour. Pleasant head and nice expression. Dark eye. Moved well. **Best Special Beginners**

Puppy Bitch

1st: BOWLES-ROBINSON's Baldragon Forever Unique. NAF TAF. Very promising tricolour of lovely breed type. Beautiful head with with dark eye and good dome. Nice size and shape with excellent neck and shoulder, short cobby body and good rear angulation. Kept a good topline on the move.

2nd: CONSTABLE's Mitapip Nightshade. Nice size B/t with good neck and shoulder and well bent stifle. Not the substance of one above.

Post Graduate Bitch

1st: LOVEL's Cofton Dreamed A Dream at Lovetrac. Lovely size tricolour with a very pretty head and sweet expression. Lovely dark eyes with well cushioned foreface and good earset. Well angulated front and rear and moved well keeping a good topline. **Res.Bitch CC**

2nd: HAYWARD & WALKER's Baldragon Little Mistress. Short backed, well marked tricolour with a pleasing head and expression. Very typical of her breeding. Moved well.

Limit Bitch

1st: ABBOTT's Cofton Reach For The Stars. Very pretty tricolour with a lovely temperament and sweet expression. Nice size and shape. Happy mover.

Open Bitch

1st: RIX's Baldragon Fame Game at Ricksbury. Very sound, well constructed tricolour with a lovely outline. Nicely arched neck and good shoulders, short cobby body and good rear angles. Pleasing head with well domed skull and good earset, large dark eyes and good width of jaw. Moved well holding her good topline and tail carriage. **Bitch CC.**
