Puppy Dog (3, 0A):

1st Smith's Chacombe Just Magical for Justacharma – 10 month tri with a strong head, dark eyes, low set ears, correct muzzle with dark pigmentation, well sprung ribs, moved well.

2nd Morley & Hitchcock's Baldragon Dream Chaser at LizLanmore – 6.5 month tricolour, correct for size, good head for size with correct dome, low set ears dark eyes and good pigmentation, moved ok.

3rd Tarabad & Whitman's Baldragon Living The Dream With Khatibi

Post Graduate Dog (4, 1A):

1st Mochrie's Downsbank Indian Ink – B/T – masculine head with correct dome, round eyes set in line with ears, bright tan markings, compact cobby body, moved well.

2nd Austin's Baldragon Blinkin Hell TAF – tricolour in a larger frame than one, masculine head with large dark round eyes, dark pigmentation. Moved ok.

3rd Tonner's Headra's Leo at Halbinsel

Limit Dog (3, 0A):

1st Baker & Kendall's Headra's Jim Beam – B/T, correct for size, masculine head, excellent dome from all angles, large dark round eyes, set in line with nose and low set ears, well cushioned muzzle with good upturn, correct neck leading into a compact cobby body, level topline with well set and carried tail, effortless movement, CC and BOB.

2nd Hardiman's Tovarich Ticket to Ride – tricolour, correct head with nice dome, low set ears and dark eye. Well constructed body although larger than one, moved well.

3rd Bowles-Robinson's Tom Des Trois Maillets Baldragon (imp Fra)

Open Dog (6, 1A):

1st Mochrie's CH Downsbank Jeffrey – lovely compact tricolour, typical head, dark eyes and pigment with bright tan markings, compact body with well sprung ribcage, level topline leading into well set tail, moved well. RCC.

2nd Bowles-Robinson's CH Baldragon Shoots He Scores – slightly larger tricolour than one with a nicely marked body, correct head with good dome and dark eyes, dark pigment, well laid shoulder leading into a well sprung ribcage, moved ok.

3rd Smith's CH Justacharma Magic Goes On

Veteran Dog (3, 0A):

1st Tonner's Headra's Inspiration At Halbinsel – 9 year old tricolour looking good for his age, tpy head still with dark pigment and rich tan markings, cobby body with well laid shoulders and correct depth to chest, moved out well.

2nd Pearce's Downsbank Troubadour over Ozzymoon – tricolour who is smaller than one, nice head with large dark round eyes and low set ears, dark pigmentation, moved ok.

3rd Austin's Dragonheart Winter Morning

Puppy Bitch (5, 0A):

1st Lovel's Lovetrac Kamilla – 10 month beautiful tricolour who caught my eye as soon as she entered the ring, correct size, prettiest of heads with excellent, gorgeous dark eyes, low set ears, dark pigmentation, good reach of neck leading into a compact and well constructed body, she will have a bright future, BCC and BP

2nd Bowles-Robinson's Lovetrac Katrina Baldragon – litter sister to first, another with a nice head and well constructed throughout, just preferred movement on 1 today.

3rd Smith & Healey-Gates' Chacombe Just Charming

Junior Bitch (3, 1A):

1st Baker's Cofton Part Of Your World – 16 month tricolour, sweet head with large dark round eyes, dark pigmentation, compact body, with well placed shoulder and well sprung ribs, good tail set, moved well.

2nd Gurtner's Una De Melcourt – 14 month tricolour, pretty head with dark eyes, good pigmentation, slightly longer in body than one, moved ok.

Post Graduate Bitch (2, 1A):

1st Austin's Tess Des Trois Maillets Baldragon (imp Fra) – richly coloured Blenheim, with a pretty head, nicely marked, large dark round eyes, dark nose, moved ok.

Limit Bitch (2, 0A):

1st Tarabad & Whitman's Baldragon Russian Around With Khatibi – 2.5 year old tricolour, good head with large dark round eyes, muzzle well cushioned with dark nose, compact body with correct shoulder placement, good spring of ribs, moved out well.

2nd Austin's Baldragon Gots Hattitude – 4 year old tricolour larger than one, typical head with large dark round eyes, moved ok.

Open Bitch (3, 2A):

1st Bowles-Robinson's Baldragon Worth Russian For – 2 year old tricolour of correct size, with a compact body, well topline and good ribs, well marked body, moved well.

Veteran Bitch (1, 0A):

1st Tuesley & Swaine's CH/Am CH Marsward Black Magic Woman – 10 year old B/T not showing her age, pretty head with dark round eyes, set correctly with low set ears and good dome, cobby body with correct shoulder placement, effortless movement and in good coat. RCC and BVIB.
