Baby Puppy Dog (0,0)

Baby Puppy Bitch (1,0)

1. Boyer's Ellinghurst Kiwirrkurra

5 month old B&T puppy bitch with pleasing head, dark eye and pleasing expression. Decent width to chin, and open nostrils. Balanced shape for age. Moved well once settled. Best Baby Puppy in Show.

Veteran Dog (1,1)

Minor Puppy Dog (2,0)

1. Smith's Chacombe Hendrix At Justacharma

Tri male 8 month old puppy, with lovely head, and expression. Nice dark eye and well placed nose with open nostrils. Good width and turn up of jaw. Enough neck and decent shoulders with good width to chest. Level topline and nice rib. Low set tail which is carried well on the move. Moved well once settled. In good coat for age of correct texture. Best Puppy Dog.

2. Maddison's MItapip MacAllan

8 month old B&T with pleasing head, dark eye, well-placed nose and ears with good feathering developing. Decent underjaw good for bone. Decent chest and rib. Moved well when settled but gave his handler a tough time due to his playful nature.

1. Maddison's Mitapip MacAllan

Junior Dog (3,2)

1. Smith's Justacharma Magic Retained

Nice, lightly marked, tricolour male with pleasing (head with wide blaze, dark eye and well-feathered ears and width if jaw. Decent bone, enough neck and good shoulder placement. Level topline and good rib. Well set tail which he carried well. Good rear action, moved well.

Yearling Dog (4,1)

1. Smith's Chacombe Magical For Justacharma

Lovely tricolour with pleasing head, dark eye head, well-set ears, good nose placement and good width to underjaw. Cobby body with decent bone, straight front, good spring of rib and topline. Correctly set tail. Well-muscled rear, he moved with drive, once settled.

2. Matches' Baldragon French Connexion At Fochai

18 month old, heavier marked tri colour boy with nicely domed head, dark eye, well-placed ears and good width to underjaw., giving overall, lovely expression. Decent recent of neck, flowing into good shoulders, well-sprung ribs and level topline. Moved well in both directions. Very pleasing, balanced shape, whilstr on the move, in profile.

3. Newman's Baldragon French Kisses

Post Graduate Dog (4,2)

Blenheim male with pleasing head, enough neck, well-laid shoulder placement and level top line. Difficult to assess his movement today, as his handler worked hard to keep him settled, due to over-enthusiasm.

Limit Dog (4,2)

1. Abbott's Helmajon Rhapsody In Blue

Four and a half year old tricolour with pleasing head, well domed skull, dark eye, good nose placement, good width of underjaw, with well cushioned muzzle. Deep chest, good amount of bone. Nice neck and shoulder, and level topline. Carried his tail a little high on the move. Good mover. Well presented.

2. Rushton's Tiflin We All Love Jack

6 year old tricolour, mature male. Good head, with dark eye , nicely placed, well feathered ears, good nose placement and nice width to muzzle an underjaw. Decent neck and good shoulders, well sprung ribs. Well presented in good coat. Moved well.

Open Dog (3,1)

1. Maddison's Justacharma Northern Magic

Five year old, mature, tricolour male with good head dark eye, well-placed nose and good cushioning on muzzle. Well feathered ears and enough dome to skull crating a pleasing expression. Balanced, overall shape with good tailset. Moved well.

2. Kendall & Baker's Cofton Tap Dance

Four year old, lightly marked with lovely head properties, dark eye, well set nose with open nostrils good cushioning to muzzle. Decent neck and shoulders and overall, body shape, although think he could carry a little more weight. Moved well. Could easily swap places with class winner on a different day.

Champion Dog (3,1)

1. Bowles-Robinson's CH Baldragon He Shoots He Scores

Quality, mature tricolour male, who today, was in full bloom. Masculine head, with dark, expressive eyes, good nose placement and excellent with of jaw with enough cushioning.

Good neck and shoulder, straight front and decent neck. Level topline and good ribcage. Nice tail carriage. Overall, well-balanced shape in profile He moved well with drive, from his well-angulated rear. Today, Well-presented, in good coat, I could not deny him the CC and RBIS.

2. Ryan's CH Cavallibrook Blimey O Riley

Another quality tricolour male with a lovely, well-domed head, dark eye, good nose placement with open nostrils, nice width of jaw with good cushioning, and nicely feathered ears, giving an overall lovely expression. Nice neck and well laid back shoulders, flowing into level topline. Moved well with drive from the rear. Very close decision between class winner, could easily change place on a different day. Reserve CC.

Veteran Bitch (2,0)

1. Potter's Toyswood Starlight Express

Seven and a half year old tricolour with pleasing head and expression. Nicely dome, dark eye and well-place nose, ears and good width to jaw. Good neck, shoulder and topline. Moved well. BVIS.

2. Abbott's Cofton Reach For The Stars

8 year old, lightly marked tricolour, with decent head, dark eye, good nose placement and decent width to jaw. Overall, balanced shape with enough neck and level topline. Just not as true in movement today,

Minor Puppy Bitch (5,0)

1. Bowles-Robinson's Baldragon Remember Me

Lovely, 8 month old, tricolour puppy, who took my eye on entering the ring. Lovely head with good dome, dark eye, good nose placement and nice width to jaw for a puppy. melting expression. Lovely front, good neck and shoulder, flowing into level topline. Liked her attitude going around the ring. Very balanced in profile. Decent front, just needs to tighten up in rear action. Should have a bright future. BPIS.

2. Selby's Baldragon Pride Of Place At Zilcan NAFTAF

Little sister to class winner with many of the same attributes. Lovely, domed head, with dark eye, good nose placement and earset, giving an overall, Moved well in both directions. Would prefer a little more leg length to create a more balanced outline in profile at the moment. Nevertheless, a very close decision and I am sure, she will have a bright future also.

1. Kendall's Headra's Killer Queen

14 month old, lightly marked, tricolour with good, nicely domed head, dark eye, good ear nose and ear placement and decent underjaw. Good neck and shoulder, level topline and good tail carriage. Needs to fill out in body, but has plenty of time to develop and mature. Decent angulation, moved well, when settled.

Yearling Bitch (5,2)

2 year old tricolour with a decent enough head, dark eye, well set nose with open nostrils and good earset. Decent neck and shoulder with level topline and good tailset. Lacks body at the moment, and hopefully she will fill out as she matures. Moved ok.

Post Graduate Bitch (3,0)

1. Hardiman's Tovarich Take Me Higher

Fully coated B&T with pleasing head with good eye and nose placement and enough cushioning to muzzle, giving an overall pleasing expression. Good neck and shoulder placement, nice topline. Moved well, but lacked animation today.

2. Abbott's Helmajon Clara's Romance

Lightly marked Blenheim with pleasing head, Decent head with wide blaze, good eye, nose placement, earset giving overall, pleasing expression. Decent neck and shoulder placement. Level topline. Moved ok.

3. Abbott's Helmajon Smyth's Cadenza

Limit Bitch (4,1)

1. Ryan's Chacombe Deacon At Cavallibrook JW

Tricolour, who is a lovely dog to go over. Beautiful head with melting expression. Lovely dome, dark eye, well set nose with open nostrils. Well-set ears, with good feathering. Excellent width and depth to jaw with good cushioning. Lovely front assembly, good neck, well laid shoulders, good spring of rib and level topline, Lovely bone. Moved very well in front and rear action and looks a picture in profile. Beautifully presented an handled to get the best out of her. Wanted to take her home My find of the day, I was delighted to award her CC and BIS.

 Good neck and decent shoulder and topline. Not as true in movement as class winner.

Tri-colour with, dark eye, well-placed nose, good width to jaw and good earset, giving an overall pleasing expression. Decent neck and shoulders placement, level topline and good tailset. Moved well. A little out of coat today,

 Lightly marked tricolour with a lovely head, dark eye good width to jaw and good earset. Decent neck and shoulder, with good ribcage and level topline. Moved well. Very close decision.

Champion Bitch (2,1)

Lovley tricolour bitch with lovely head, with nice dome, dark eye, black nose with open nostrils and good ear placement and good width to underjaw, giving an overall, feminine, melting expression.
