PD (1, 0)

1 Tarabad & Whitman Artus Charming Line at Khatibi (Imp CZE) a puppy with a very bright future ahead of him. He has a really lovely head that is very much to the standard i.e. his eyes ears and nose placement are super. He's a well-balanced puppy with good neck and shoulders sound and Coby in body. I was very taken with the richness of tan. He impressed on the move very promising.

JD (3, 0)

1 Lovel Lovetrac Kasper RDCC a tricolour of great quality. Classic head, good balance throughout with excellent bone. Shown in lovely condition and he moves so soundly. Should have a good future also. BJIB

2 Tarabad & Whitman Khatibi's Night Howl BPIB is a beautiful King Charles. I'd be happy to own. His head fits the breed standard so well as does his body proportions. A little loose in movement but otherwise he's fabulous and I wish his owner every success with him.

3 Spall & Clark Khatibi Ken Ya Believe I'm at Llapsttam I would like to say also that I found the dog standing third to be of supper quality

1 Maddison Mitapip Macallan black & tan a quality dog that I've admired on several occasions. He's got a pleasing head and at 19 months is maturing nicely. He moves soundly but could put more into it and settle.

LD (1, 0)

1 Matches Baldragon French Conexion at Fochai 2-year-old tri with good bold head and a Coby body, good bone and moving well.

OD (2, 0)

1 Ryan Ch Cavallibrook Blimey O Riley a mature male at his prime. He's got a beautiful head, correct width of muzzle and clean under jaw. Super neck and shoulders, good spring of rib. A very sound and free moving dog. So full of energy, he stormed around the ring displaying good movement. I was delighted to award him his 24th DCC & BOB. He looked very good with his handler in the group.

2 Maddison Justacharma Northern Magic a very mature male with attractive head and a well-balanced body. Could have been a little more settled on the move. A dog with much to admire.

PB (1, 0)

1 Selby Pys Delila for Zilcan 10 months with a lot of quality. She is lacking maturity at the moment but she has promise. I particularly liked her sound confident movement and that lovely level topline.

JB (2, 1)

1 Lovel Lovetrac Diwali tricolour of good breed type. I liked her size and her head is feminine. She has a well-proportioned body with good bone. Could tighten up in front.

PGB (3, 1)

1 Hayward & Walker Justacharma Magic Dance Dalshareon 2 years old another I've admired in the past. She is well proportioned and carries herself happily round the ring. Her size also appeals.

2 Ratter Chacombe Catch A Star for Seafar a quality bitch that could carry herself better. She has a sweet feminine head with doomed skull, good neck and shoulders. A sound bitch that could make more of herself.

LB (4, 0)

1 Bowles-Robinson Baldragon Remember Me beautiful bitch with classic head, so feminine. She is well balanced with good leg length. There's so much to like about this bitch but sadly today she just wasn't going as well as I've seen her in the past.

2 Tarabad & Whitman Yeshalomi Day to Remember for Khatibi JW this bitch has possibly the best Blenheim head I've seen in a long time. I thought she lacked a little body, otherwise she is beautiful and deserves to be a champion.

3 Potter Justacharma Magic Trix

OB (4, 0) This was a lovely class of quality.

1 Lovel Ch Lovetrac Kamilla BCC tri of lovely quality throughout. In lovely coat and condition. A most attractive head with lovely dark expressive eyes, good reach of neck and a Coby body. She moves with confidence and her coat was immaculate.

2 Tarabad & Whitman Ch Baldragon Russian Around with Khatibi RBCC impressive bitch that carries herself so well. One I recently admired a few weeks ago and while I thought her up to size, she is outstanding in all other aspects of the breed.

3 Selby Ch Baldragon Pride of Place at Zilcan

1 Bowles-Robinson & Jones Ch Chacombe Marana Baldragon she certainly displays the lasting qualities in the breed. A well broken and well-balanced tri I've admired in the past.
