PD (4) 1 Amantra Thatcher's Gold (Jackson) - 8 months Ruby. Super cobby outline on this very promising youngster. He has such a handsome head; correct domed skull, jet black eyes that were set well apart, low set ears, short muzzle. He carried his head well on a good neck. His chest was deep and wide. Level top line. He was a positive mover in front, just needs a touch more strength in his rear. His chestnut red coat was gleaming like a new pin in the sun. Well handled and schooled. His quality breed type won him BEST PUPPY IN BREED. 2 Cavallibrook Crikey Mikey (Ryan) - A real baby of 6 months, Tri. Loved the bone and substance on this baby. His outline was perfect, cobby and compact. Glorious head piece, smashing domed skull, low set ears with good fringing already, his muzzle square and wide. Good neck and top line. Sound front straight legs and a nicely angulated rear. His correctly marked coat was in beautiful condition. Just needs to settle on the move. Full of promise. 3 Artus Charming Line at Khatibi (Imp Cze) (Tarabad & Whitman)

JD (4,1)1 Khatibi's Night Howl Tarabad & Whitman) - Nearly 10 months, lightly marked Tri. Another with lovely bone and substance. His eyes were large round and dark giving a soft expression. His muzzle was square with neat finish to his lips. Good length of neck leading to well laid shoulders. Good ribbing with a deep chest. His rear was adequately angulated and firm with muscle tone. Moved with drive and style. Shown in first class condition. 2nd Place 2180 - Marchog Make Way for Ellinghurst (Mr P & Mrs S Boyer) - Ruby, 12 months. Slightly longer cast than 1st place. What a beautiful head, correct domed skull with dark expressive eyes, well filled muzzle and neat lips. I liked his neck and well laid shoulders. Clean straight front. Nicely angulated rear. He moved very well from both directions. His rich red chestnut coat was in amazing condition, shining like a new mirror. Lots to like here. 3 Lovetrac Kasper (Lovel)

GD (3) 1 Chacombe Harry On Downsbank (Mochrie) - Tri, 19 months. Typical head here with low set ears, good rise to his dome, large dark intelligent eyes, he has cracking large open healthy nostrils. Good reach of neck leading to a level top line. Perhaps could be a smidgen shorter in loin for ideal outline? He moves with style and elegance. Shown in lovely coat. Once he matures more in body he will trouble the best. Liked him. 2 Headra's Don't Stop Me Now at Halbinsel (Tonner) - 2 years, Tri. A very happy showman here, tail never stopped wagging. His head and expression are Ok. Another that could be shorter coupled for ideal outline. His coat was very nicely marked and presented in first class condition. Sound free mover. 2 Baldragon Pardon My French (Austin)

LD (2) 1 Amantra Kings Oak (Jackson & Champion) - Tri, 2 and half years. Fabulous head piece, round dark eye, healthy open nostrils, square muzzle with very neat lips. I loved his bone and substance throughout. Square outline with a level top line. Very sound front and rear and moved with ease around the ring. Shown in full bloom with quality coat and presentation. 2 Amantra Tomatin (Jackson & Melville) - 2 years, Blen. A strong sound mover from all directions. I preferred the more domed skull on the winner. He excels in body shape, super cobby body that was compact. He has fabulous bone and substance throughout. His coat was beautifully presented and silky to the touch.

OD (5,2) 1 Ch Cofton All I Hav to Do Is Dream with Khatibi ShCEx (Tarabad & Whitman) - Fully mature Tri that has an excellent silhouette. His skull is perfectly domed, his well fringed ears are low set, his dark round eyes are expressive, he has big open nostrils and his muzzle is square, wide and well turned up. I liked his compact body shape. Sound front and a well angulated rear with excellent muscle tone. He moves so well in front and rear. Happy showman who never put a paw wrong. Shown in super coat and condition. Delighted to award him with the DCC. 2 Downsbank Indian Ink (Mochrie) - B&T. This exuberant lad was proving to be a bit of a handful for his handler. He oozes breed type; classic Charlie dome, large round dark eyes, excellent healthy open nostrils, well cushioned cheeks, good turn up and adequate underjaw. His well furnished ears were low set. Good reach of neck, level compact body. Excellent ribbing. Shown in full coat that was correctly marked. He just needs to settle a touch more. His breed type won him the RDCC. 3 Baldragon Blinkin Hell (Austin)

VD (1) 1 Tovarich Ticket to Ride (Hardiman) - Tri, 9 years. An ultra sound moving Charlie in both directions. His head and skull shape were ok, typical eyes, healthy nostrils, square and wide muzzle. Super strong top line, excellent ribs and a well set tail. His nicely marked coat was in beautiful order. Happy and showy temperament. A credit to his owner.

PB (4,1) 1 Baldragon's Shooting Star for Lizlanmor (Morley & Hitchcock) - Tri, 10 months. Spot on for balance and size. Ultra feminine head, correct domed skull with the darkest of eyes. Her nose placement was good and she has open healthy nostrils, her muzzle is squarish and its wide. Her cheeks are nicely cushioned and she has a firm underjaw. I liked her neck and cobby body. She moved soundly once she settled into herself. First class presentation, nice silky textured coat. Coat could be a touch more broken. Lots to admire here. 2 Khatibi Bev Early Night (Tarabad & Whitman) - A real baby of just 6 months, Blen. Very pretty head that was nicely domed. Square muzzle of good depth. Large round eyes giving a soft expression. Moderate length of neck, well laid shoulders and a clean straight front. Good top line. Smidgen long in loin. Needs to settle on the move but she is just a baby. 3 Cavallibrook Jeez Louise Parcauwen (Rees)

JB (3,1) Rignolla Devon Dreamer with Potbelli (Rutherford) - Super well balanced outline on the young Blen. Her temperament was fabulous, never stopped showing. Her well broken coat was an excellent silky texture and presented to perfection. Feminine domed head, low set ears that were well fringed, dark expressive eyes, good nose placement, and neat lips. Her body shape is typical; compact with strong loin. She was an eye catching mover, so sound from every angle. Expertly handled and very well schooled. 2 Khatibi Czech Me Out (Tarabad & Whitman) - 11 months, Tri. This puppy was a little unsettled on the move to begin with, but once she got the hang of it, she stormed around the ring. I loved her head and expression, so typical. Moderate length of neck leading to well laid shoulders. A smidgen long in loin. Well angulated rear with good muscle. Correctly marked coat. First class coat condition.

PGB (4,2) 1 Mitapip Tatianna Tovarich (Hardiman) B&T. What a beautiful head this girl has, her skull was perfectly domed. Gorgeous dark expressive eyes, good nose placement and quality underjaw. Her head was carried proudly on her moderate neck. Excellent shoulders and top line. Could be a touch shorter in back. Moved out so soundly up and down. Happy temperament. Just lacked a little coat today. 2 Justacharma Magic Trix NAF TAF (Potter) - Tri. What a super outline on this one, compact and sturdy in body. Her neck and top line were good. Excellent ribs. She moved out nicely. Her coat was nicely marked and was in lovely order. Her head shape was ok, just not as domed in skull as 1st place.

LB (4,2) 1 Yeshalomi Day to Remember for Khatibi JW (Tarabad & Whitman) - Blen. Nice broken coat of correct silky texture. Ultra sound on the move, free and elegant. Feminine in head with all the essentials. Good width and depth to muzzle, strong underjaw. Low set well feathered ears. Her chest is wide with plenty of healthy heart room. Correct front and rear angles. 2 Tess Des Trois Maillets Baldragon (Imp Fra) (Bowles-Robinson) - Blen. Fabulous cobby outline on this one. I liked her skull shape, nice unexaggerated dome. Large dark eyes giving a soft expression. Healthy open nostrils although her pigment could be better. Well laid shoulders with clean straight front. Her rear is well angulated with firm muscle tone. She moves well coming towards but a touch close behind today. Her well broken coat was beautifully presented.

OB (5,2) 1 Ch Baldragon Russian Around with Khatibi (Tarabad & Whitman)- BCC, BoB & Shortlisted in the Toy Group. 5 years, Tri. Easily one of the strongest movers today, so parallel, sound and stylish. Her showmanship is second to none, her tail never stops wagging. She has a good outline, compact body frame with proud head carriage. Her domed skull is typical, low set well feathered ears, large dark eyes giving a super expression. Her nose placement is correct with good nostrils. Her muzzle is squarish, and its short and wide. Loved her neck and top line. Sound straight front with strong but not overdone bone. Her stifles in the rear are well bent and she has super firm muscle tone. A true toy Spaniel that ticked all my boxes today. 2 Ch Lovetrac Kamilla (Lovel) - Tri. A smaller and daintier girl. Loved her typical head and expression. She has a super front and rear. Her ribs are nice and she has good depth of chest. Her well marked coat was presented to perfection. Her top line wasn't as strong as 1st and she didn't move out as well. 3 Ch Baldragon Pride of Place at Zilcan (Selby)

VB (2) 1 Ch Chacombe Marana Baldragon (Bowles-Robinson & Jones) - 9 years, RCC & BEST VETERAN. WoW, what fabulous condition this 9 year old Tri was in. Her outline is spot on, compact and cobby. Her head was simply glorious, unexaggerated dome, low set ears that were lovely fringed. Her eyes dark, round and so typical. Muzzle wide and deep with neat lips. Strong neck and top line. Excellent well laid shoulders with straight front legs. Her rear tidy with good angulation. Her nicely marked coat was in pristine condition, every hair accounted for. Her movement was steady, free and elegant. She just oozes breed type! 2 Ellinghurst Kiki Dee (Boyer)- 8 years, Tri. Another typey veteran shown in tip top condition. Her body shape is correct, cobby with well sprung

ribs. Spirit level top line with good tail set and carriage. She moves well in front but a smidgen untidy in rear. Her head is very typical with all the essentials. I must mention this exhibitor's presentation skills, all her dogs were in gleaming condition, congratulations.

Andrew D Stewart (Ingerdorm)
