1ST 14127 - Khatibi Ken Ya Believe I'm at Llapsttam (Mr M & Mr M Spall & Clark)

Well-broken 11-month-old tricolour with a pleasing head for his age, correct dome, well-cushioned, short square muzzle, well-defined stop, wide nostrils, lovely dark eye giving a gentle expression and well-set ears. Ample bone for his age, good spring of rib and presented in excellent condition. A little preoccupied on the move today, which at times prevented him from showing himself to his best advantage. Nevertheless, a promising youngster with much to admire, and I was later pleased to award him the Reserve Dog CC and Best Puppy.

1ST 14117 - Lovetrac Kasper (Mr P F Lovel)

16-month-old tricolour with a classic head and expression, large dome, large dark eye, well-defined stop, short square muzzle and well-set ears. Short, compact body with a pleasing amount of coat and a lovely spring of rib. Would benefit from a tidier front action on the move, but overall a pleasing youngster with much to like.

1862. King Charles Spaniel - Post Graduate Dog Entries: 2 Absentees: 0

1ST 14126 - Chacombe Hank at Paulian (Mrs P Sidgwick)

Well-broken tricolour with a masculine head, well-defined stop, moderate eye and short square muzzle. Good reach of neck flowing into a level topline when standing. Would benefit from a little more spring of rib, which should come with maturity. A little unsettled on the move today.

2ND 14118 - Mitapip Macallan (Miss S Maddison)

Well-presented black and tan of similar size with rich, dark tan markings, presented in excellent condition. Pleasing head and expression. Still needs time to mature in body and depth of chest. Shown to advantage.

1ST 14112 - Cavella Carson (Mrs L.M. Gillhespy)

Richly coloured black and tan with a quality head and gentle expression. Lovely dark eye, good dome, well-defined stop, short square muzzle, wide nostrils and correctly set ears. A well-balanced exhibit, with good reach of neck flowing into a level topline and correct tail carriage, presenting an attractive outline. Shown in excellent condition and presented a quality overall picture.

1ST 14124 - Ch Cavallibrook Blimey O Riley (Mrs K F Ryan)

Well-broken tricolour, well proportioned throughout. Classic head and gentle expression, with large dark eyes, well-defined stop, well-cushioned muzzle, correct tapering of the jaw and correctly set ears. Good reach of neck flowing into well-laid shoulders, good depth of chest, well sprung ribs and ample bone. Created a pleasing outline both standing and on the move, moving soundly with good drive. Pleased to award him the Dog CC and, later, Best of Breed.

1ST 14113 - Xsissi of Dvou Orechu (Mrs L.M. Gillhespy)

Beautifully presented 11-month-old black and tan with rich tan markings. Head developing nicely with a moderate dome and an appealing dark eye, with further maturity to come. Moderate neck, cobby body with good spring of rib, level topline and correct tail carriage, giving a compact outline. Good turn of stifle. Moved well for her age, and although still a little immature in front, this should strengthen with time. A promising youngster with lots of potential.

2ND 14119 - Baldragon's Shooting Star for Lizlanmor (Miss E & Mr R Morley & Hitchcock)

Beautifully shaped 10-month-old tricolour with the prettiest of heads and a typical gentle expression. Lovely eye, ample stop and a well-cushioned muzzle. Unsettled on the table and on the move. Nevertheless, a very promising youngster whose future I shall watch with interest.

1869. King Charles Spaniel - Junior Bitch Entries: 2 Absentees: 0

1ST 14116 - Lovetrac Diwali (Mr P F Lovel)

Compact, well-balanced 16-month-old tricolour with a quality head and expression. Large dome, good tapering to the muzzle with good fill, lovely eye and good depth of chest. Good reach of neck, cobby body with a pleasing outline and a super temperament. Moved well. A quality youngster with much to admire.

2ND 14123 - Rignolla Devon Dreamer with Potbelli (Miss H & Miss G & Mrs C Rutherford)

Well-proportioned, beautifully broken Blenheim with a classic head and gentle expression. Large eye, good fill and a well-tapered muzzle. Good neck and level topline with correct tail carriage, positive spring of rib and good turn of stifle. Depth of chest will come with maturity. Moved freely and was shown to advantage. Another lovely youngster with a super temperament.

1870. King Charles Spaniel - Post Graduate Bitch Entries: 1 Absentees: 0

1ST 14115 - Headra's Killer Queen JW (Mrs M E Kendall)

Tricolour with a classic head and gentle expression. Lovely eye, correct dome, well-defined stop, well-cushioned muzzle and correctly set ears. Good neck and shoulders, maintaining a level topline and correct tail carriage, creating a balanced outline when standing. Between coats on the day and would have liked a little more body. At times she was rather eager on the move, although she drove well from the rear.

1871. King Charles Spaniel - Limit Bitch Entries: 2 Absentees: 0

1ST 14114 - Baldragon French Fancy (Miss E & Mrs C Jenkinson & Bowles-Robinson)

Heavily marked tricolour of lovely breed type who caught my eye as she entered the ring. Beautiful feminine head with a large dark eye, correct dome, well-defined stop, lovely square muzzle and good fill under the lips. Good reach of neck flowing into a level topline with correct tail carriage. Compact and cobby with good depth

of chest, presenting a balanced outline. Between coats on the day but nevertheless presented a quality picture. Moved freely and in complete harmony with her handler. Delighted to award her the Bitch CC.

2ND 14122 - Marchog Moll Flanders (Mr N Robinson)

Feminine ruby with a dark eye and gentle expression. A little more fill would further enhance her expression. Compact in outline. Moved steadily on the day. Typical of the breed in temperament, reserved yet gentle.
